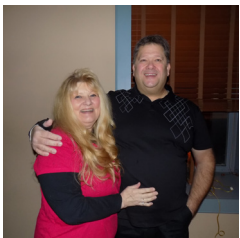
The Getaway Camp speaker this year will be Peter Farrell. Read a little bit about Peter, his wife Jill, and their family below:
